



## Selecting an Alternate C-Code Editor in ASCET

### DESIRED ACTION

The user wants to edit the code in an external C-code editor and wants to have ASCET open it automatically, rather than opening the default editor.

### CAUSE

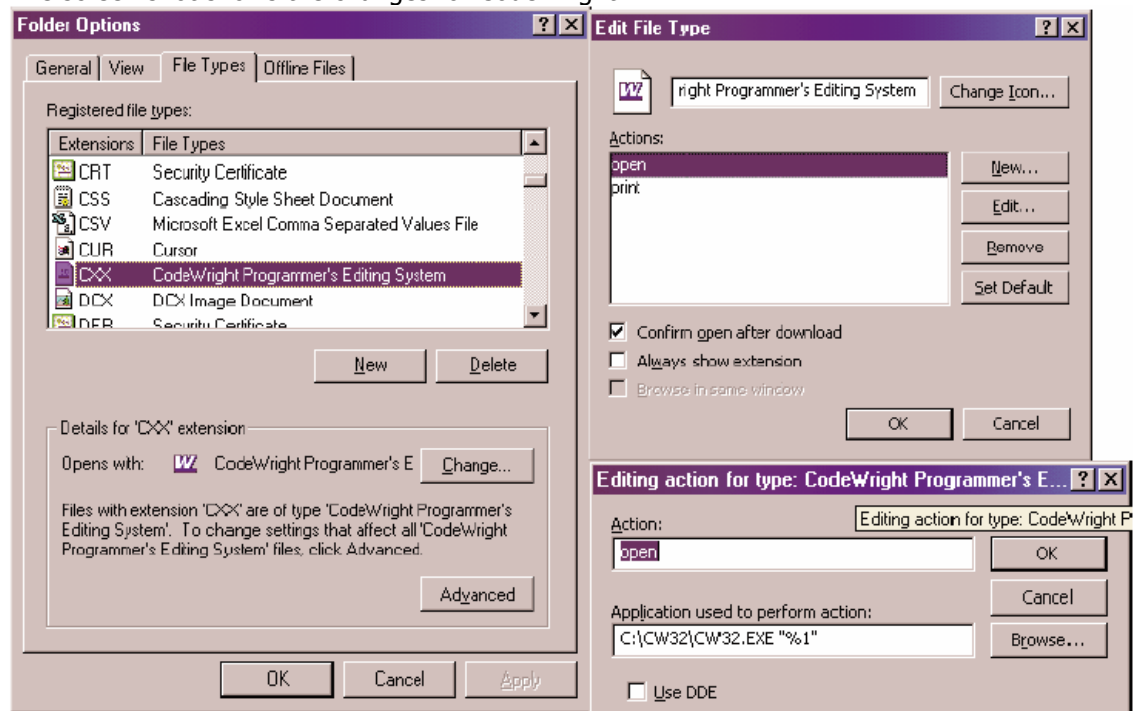
It is possible in Windows Explorer to replace the default editor for C-files by a different editor. However, this does not affect file type registration. Therefore, it is possible to open C-files in the Windows Explorer with a different editor, rather than the default editor.

### SOLUTION

In order to have ASCET use the same editor as used in Windows Explorer, the registration has to be changed as follows:

Tools -> Folder Options -> File Types -> Advanced -> Edit
