



How do you overlay characteristic curves in a curve editor?

DESIRED ACTION

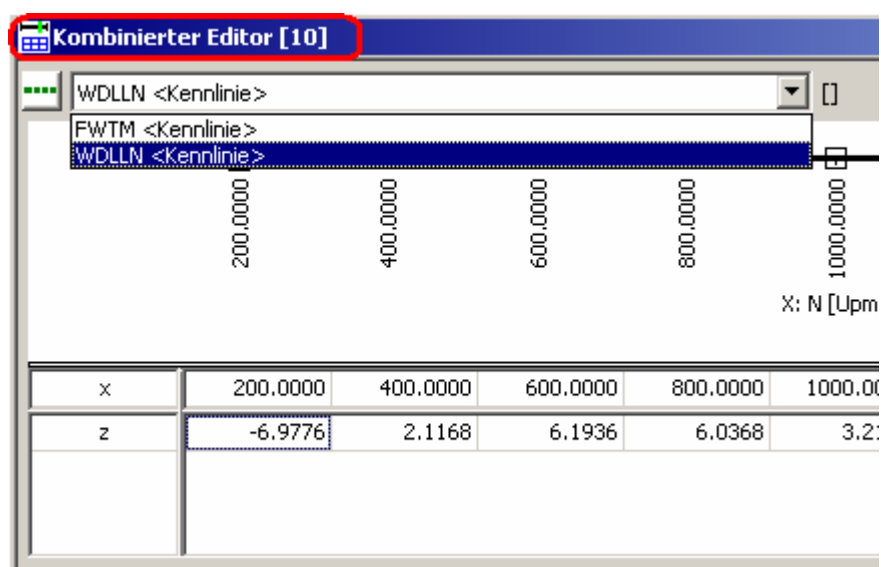
To be able to compare different characteristic curves, a user wants to view them at the same time in a curve editor.

CAUSE

The Combined Editor supports displaying several different characteristic curves in the same view through the **Overlay** feature.

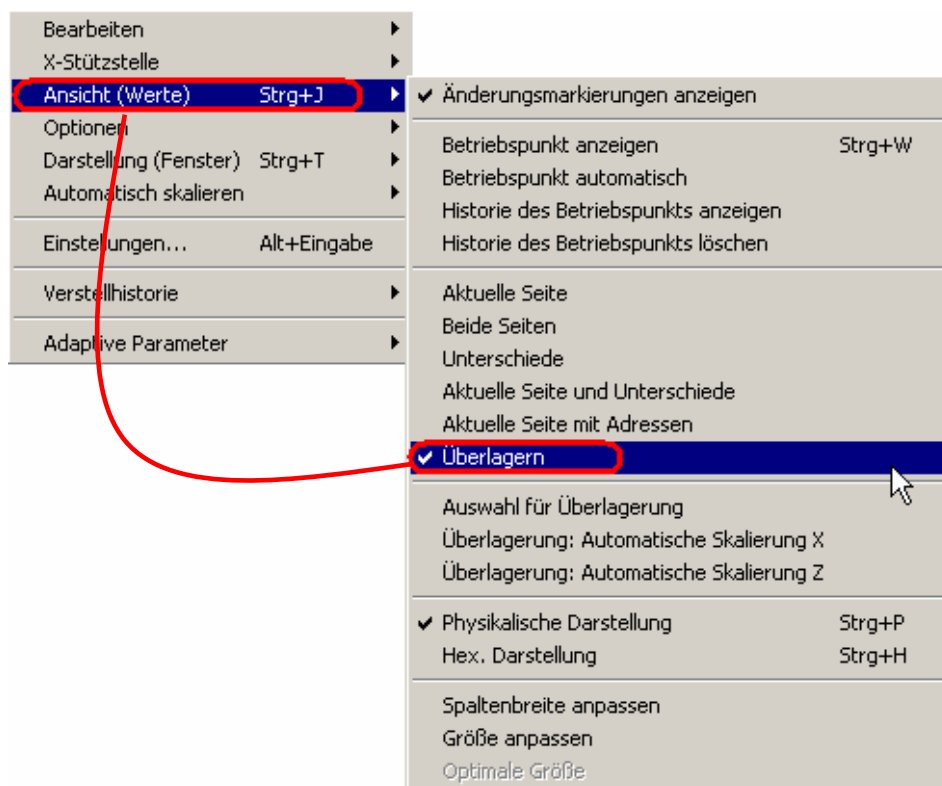
SOLUTION

In order to use this feature, please ensure that the curves to be displayed are added to a Combined Editor window.

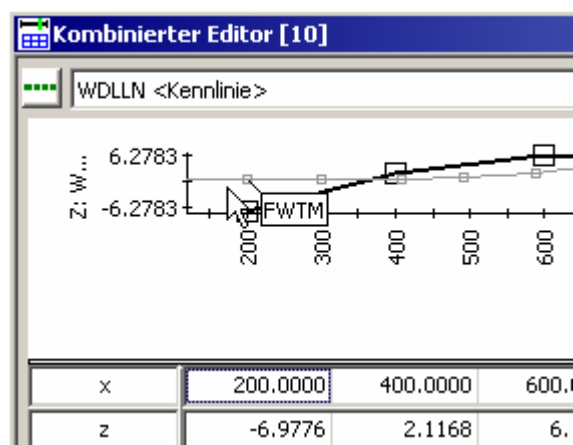


Move the mouse cursor to the curve and click the right mouse button. From the context menu select the menu option **Display value**. Then select **Overlay**.



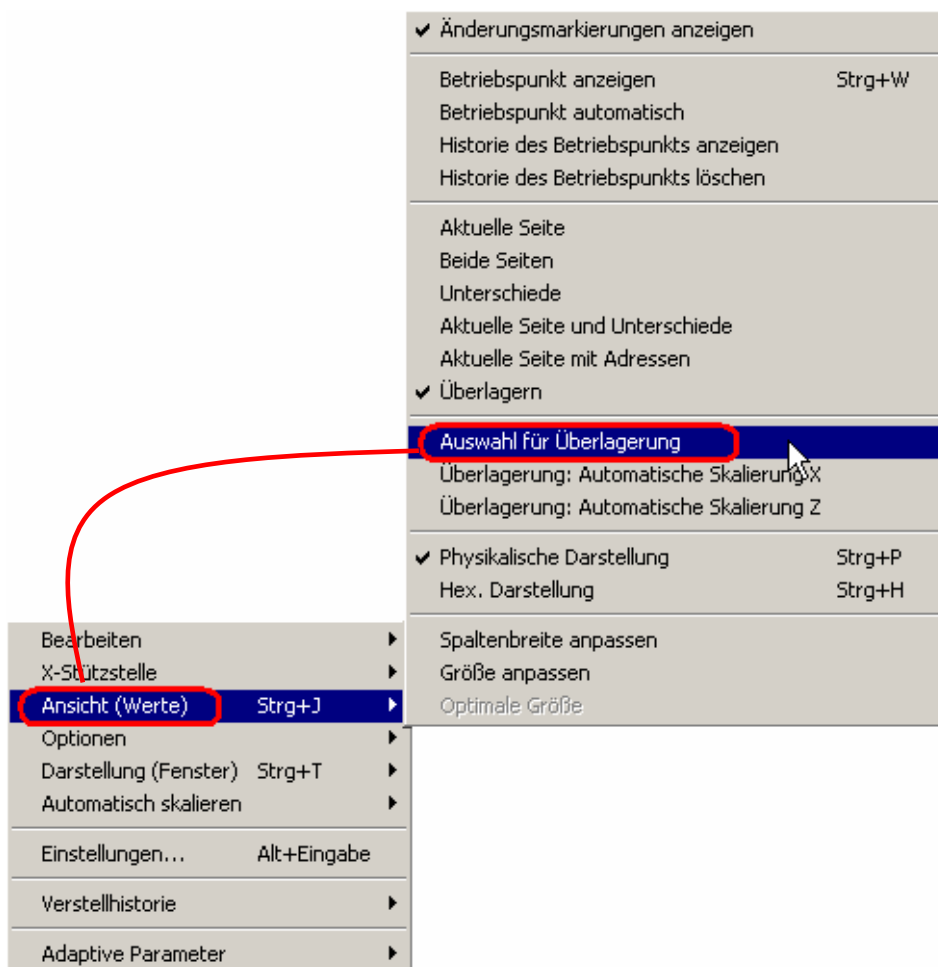


The curves will then be overlaid over the active curve in the Combined editor. If you move the mouse cursor over the overlaid curve, the name of that curve will be displayed.

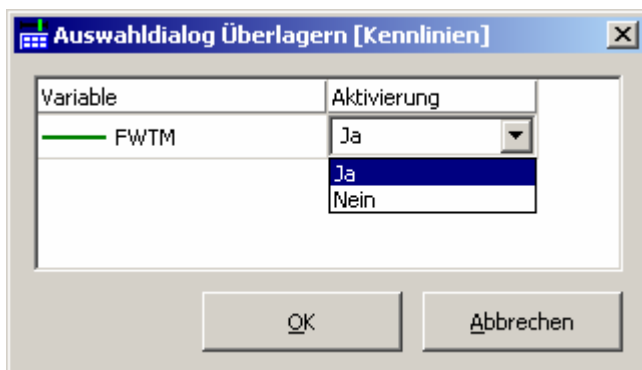


To de-activate an overlaid curve, right-click on the graphic and select the option **Display (values)** from the context menu. Then select the option **Select for overlay**.





In the dialog window **Selection dialog overlay (curves)**, you can then de-activate/active a curve by setting the option **Activate** to **Yes** or **No**.
